

Our Plan for COVID-19

Bernini Honolulu has resumed dine-in service for dinner in accordance with the most recent Emergency Order by the City and County of Honolulu. We kindly ask all our guests to make reservations in advance so that we can arrange tables to keep social distancing. The best place to make a reservation is online. However, if you do not see any available slots, or are considering dining out last minute, we encourage you to call us at 808-591-8400 to double check for availability.

As per the Emergency Order by the City and County of Honolulu, and guidance by CDC and DOH, you can expect the following when making a reservation and dining with us:

- All guests must wear face coverings when entering and leaving the restaurant as well as when using a restroom but may remove the face coverings while seated.

- Each reservation is limited to five (5) or fewer persons, and we require the name of the representative of the reservation, his / her address, and telephone number. The representative needs to show his / her ID to verify the name and address upon arrival at Bernini for dine-in.
- Guests are encouraged to preorder for dine-in service if possible.
- All guests will be required to self-screen before entering the restaurant. We will use infrared thermometer to measure the temperature of each guest, and guests will be asked to read through a listing of COVID-19 symptoms. If a guest identifies with any of the listed symptoms within the last 3 days, they are asked to not dine.
- If a guest or a member of the guest's household has arrived or returned to the State of Hawai'i within the past 14 days, please do not make a reservation until they all have self-quarantined for 14 days in compliance with the mandatory 14-day self-quarantine orders.

- All guests are encouraged to show up at the time of your reservation.

Safety for all our guests and employees is our priority. We have installed ceiling fans, air purifiers, and air circulators for restaurant ventilation in addition to the mandates and guidelines for reopening of the restaurant. All employees are temperature checked and logged upon arriving for their shifts, and they will wear masks. All tables, chairs, and condiments are cleaned and sanitized before and after each reservation.

We hope all our guests will feel safe and comfortable dining with us at Bernini Honolulu.
